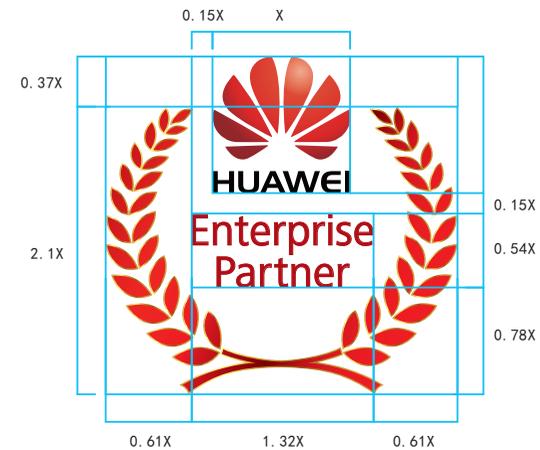

The logo for Huawei's enterprise partners (Generic) is applicable to partners in all enterprise business fields.



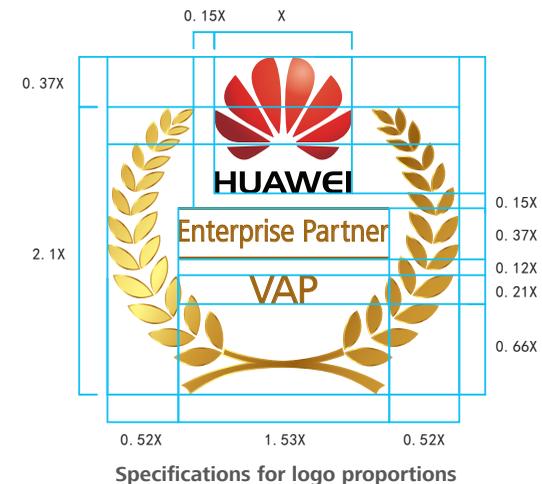
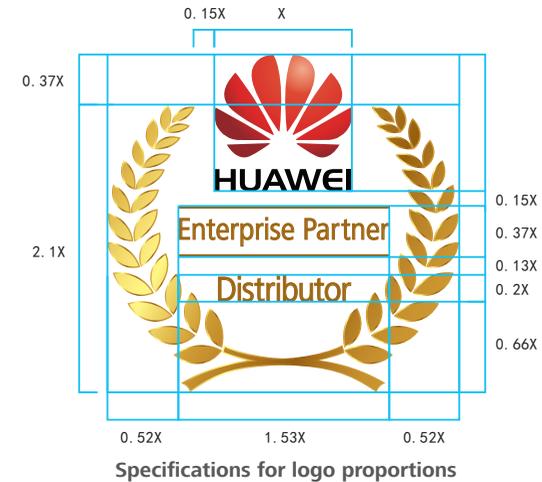

Specifications for logo proportions

Distributors attain the sales target for Huawei's enterprise products and recruit tier-2 resellers in the enterprise market to ensure region coverage. Distributors purchase goods directly from Huawei, but do not directly supply goods to users. Instead, they rely on their tier-2 resellers that supply goods to users. Distributors provide order processing, logistics, financing, and technical support services to tier-2 resellers.

Value-added partners (VAPs) attain the sales target they promise on Huawei's enterprise products and solutions, develop customer relationship platforms for specific industries, and provide technical support and branding support for Huawei's products and solutions. VAPs directly engage with users and do not need to recruit tier-2 resellers.



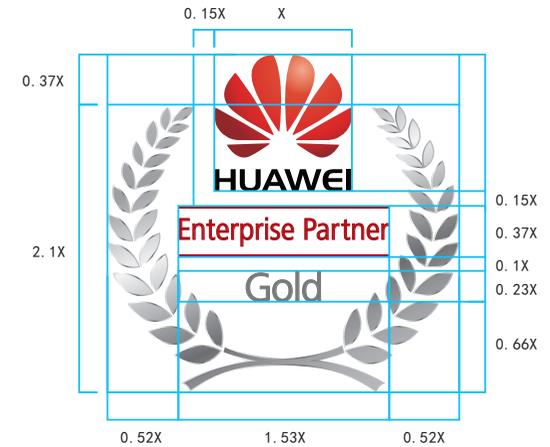
Platinum partners, gold partners, silver partners, and authorized partners attain the sales targets they promised to Huawei, provide pre-sales technical support, after-sales technical support, and branding support for Huawei's products to customer in the certified regions/industries.

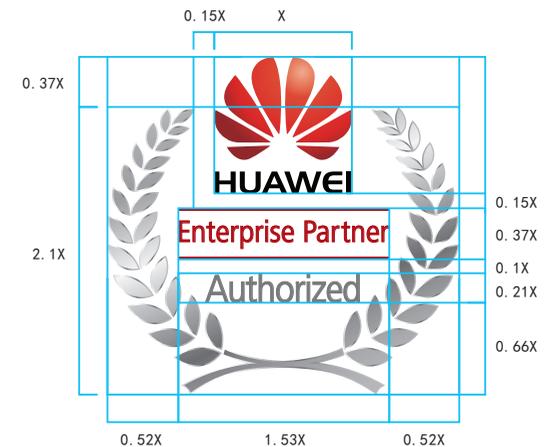

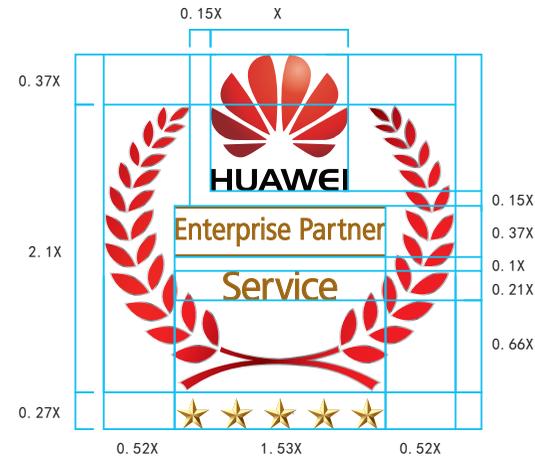
Tier-1 and tier-2 channel partners of Huawei's Enterprise BG can become Huawei's certified service partners (CSPs) after their service capabilities pass Huawei's certification.

CSPs are authorized to resell Huawei branded services or partner branded services, and can also deliver partner branded services.

CSPs are classified into three types: three-star CSPs, four-star CSPs, and five-star CSPs. More stars indicate stronger service capabilities of CSPs.

Logos for Huawei's Learning Partners

Huawei Authorized Learning Partners (HALPs) are professional training organizations who have passed Huawei's strict evaluation, receive Huawei's supervision and management, and are authorized to deliver Huawei's certification and training programs.

Huawei Certified Systems Instructors (HCSIs) are instructors who work at HALPs, have passed Huawei's competency certification, and are authorized to deliver training courses for the related certification and training programs.

Logos for Huawei Authorized Network Academies (HANAs)

HANAs are professional institutions of higher education that have passed Huawei's strict evaluation, receive Huawei's supervision and management, and are authorized to deliver Huawei's technical courses and certification exam programs.

HANAs strive to promote the education of ICT technology in institutions of higher education and help them produce ICT talent.

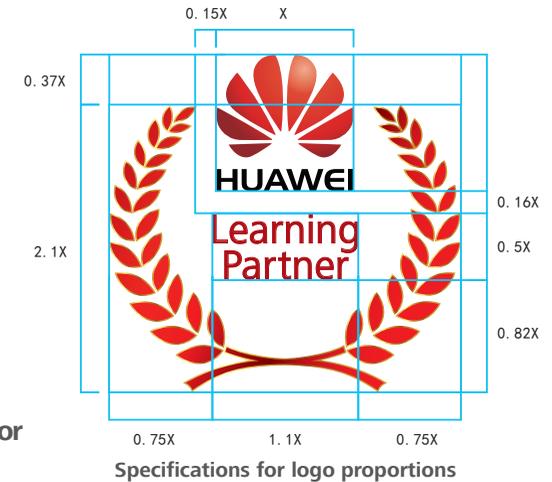

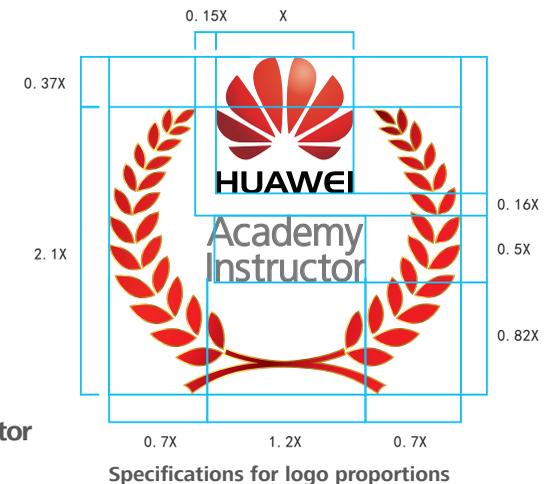

A blank space must be kept around the logos to ensure their visual effect. This space is called the restricted area. No text, symbol, or other graphic element can be displayed in this area. The width and height of the restricted area is x . x is equal to the length of two vertical Hs. The size of the restricted area changes along with the size of the logos.

The minimum size of logos in various printed publications is shown in the figure on the right. If the logos are smaller than this minimum size, they will become illegible.

1 Restricted Area

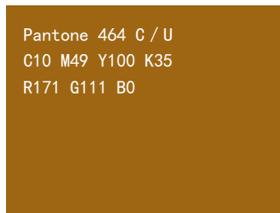


2 Minimum Size

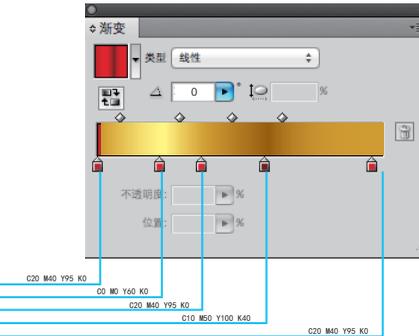


Standard colors are an important element that stands for the brand image and brand culture. They can leave a strong impression.

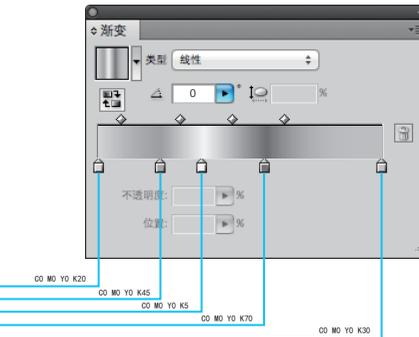
The same color will also cause some visual error under different light rays and on different materials. The color sample provided in this manual must be taken as a benchmark and the environment must be indoors on a sunny day with sufficient natural light. The colors of the logos have been standardized and shall not be modified. As there are numerous types of printers available, the color value for printing in this manual shall be taken as a reference.



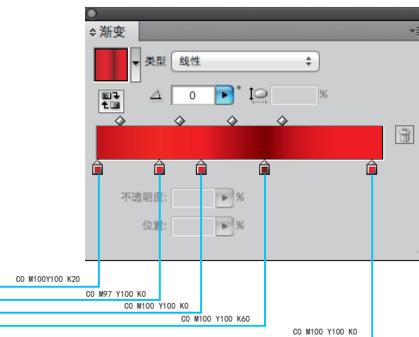
Gold gradient

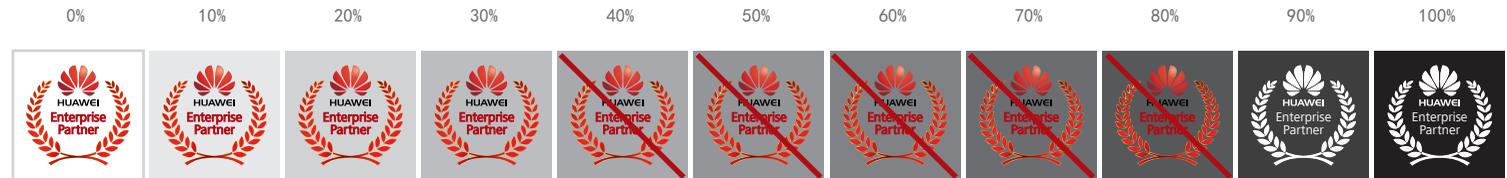
